

## **IC17** Tourist trips

- **1** A tourist is someone that visits or travels to a place for pleasure.
- 2 A heritage site is a landmark or site that is preserved because of its cultural value.
- 3 The most money on trips was spent in 2013.
- 4 The least money was spent in 2015.
- **5** R52 million R41 million = R11 million
- The main reason was that the sites were too expensive. Two fifths > one third > one quarter.
  - **b**  $\frac{2}{5} + \frac{1}{3} + \frac{1}{4} = \frac{24 + 20 + 15}{60} = \frac{59}{60}$  This does not make exactly one which is  $\frac{60}{60}$ .

- 3 If we turn a shape at an angle, we get a sense of movement.
